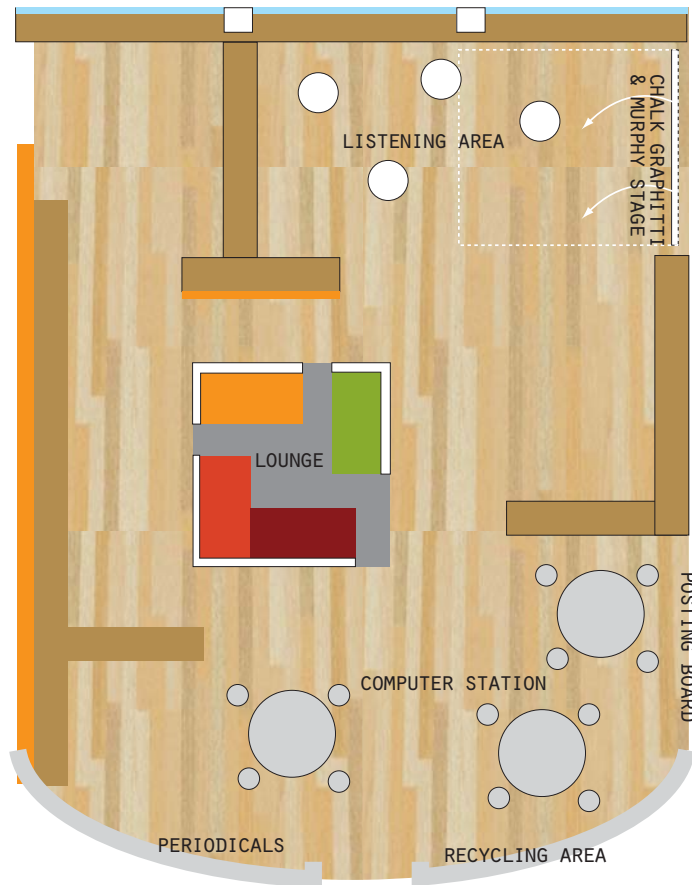


# TEEN AREA



## LISTENING AREA

This area adapts to what is happening in this space. The graffiti chalk board against the wall acts like a Murphy bed - flipping down to become a stage for events happening here. When not at use, the stage tilts up against the wall, providing more space. Movies project onto a drop down screen. Seating can move and is designed for listening. The shelving behind houses audio material.

## BOOK SHELVES

Books on the shelves are arranged to feel like a bookstore. Many are displayed with covers facing outward. The shelves are higher where the space permits, such as against the walls.

## COMPUTER STATIONS

Teens work alongside each other, which allows for the sharing and social learning that can happen here. These can be moved around. All areas in the teen section have wi-fi service, for using personal laptops are used. On logging in to the network, the browser is directed to the teen page of the library's website.

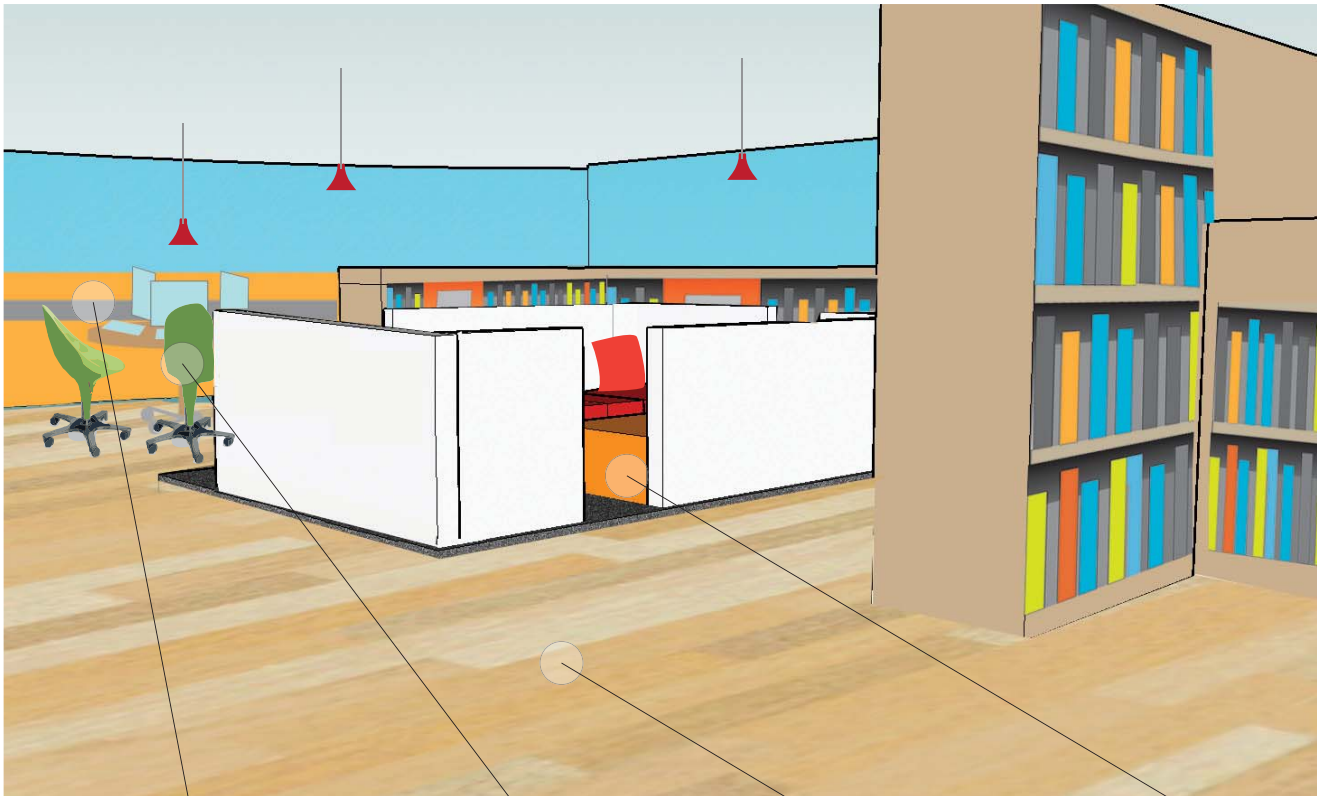
## LOUNGE

This space is a comfy place to hang, read and share ideas. The defined space of the walls makes it feel like a nook, yet keeps the space open. This is the center of it all.

## PERIODICALS/RECYCLING/POSTING BOARD

A shelf-like countertop allows for display magazines, etc running on the curve of the entrance. Recycling bins can be under them near the door. A large posting bulletin board should cover the wall near the front.

**SHELF DISPLAY**  
Running along the front, this countertop-like display showcases magazines and other materials.

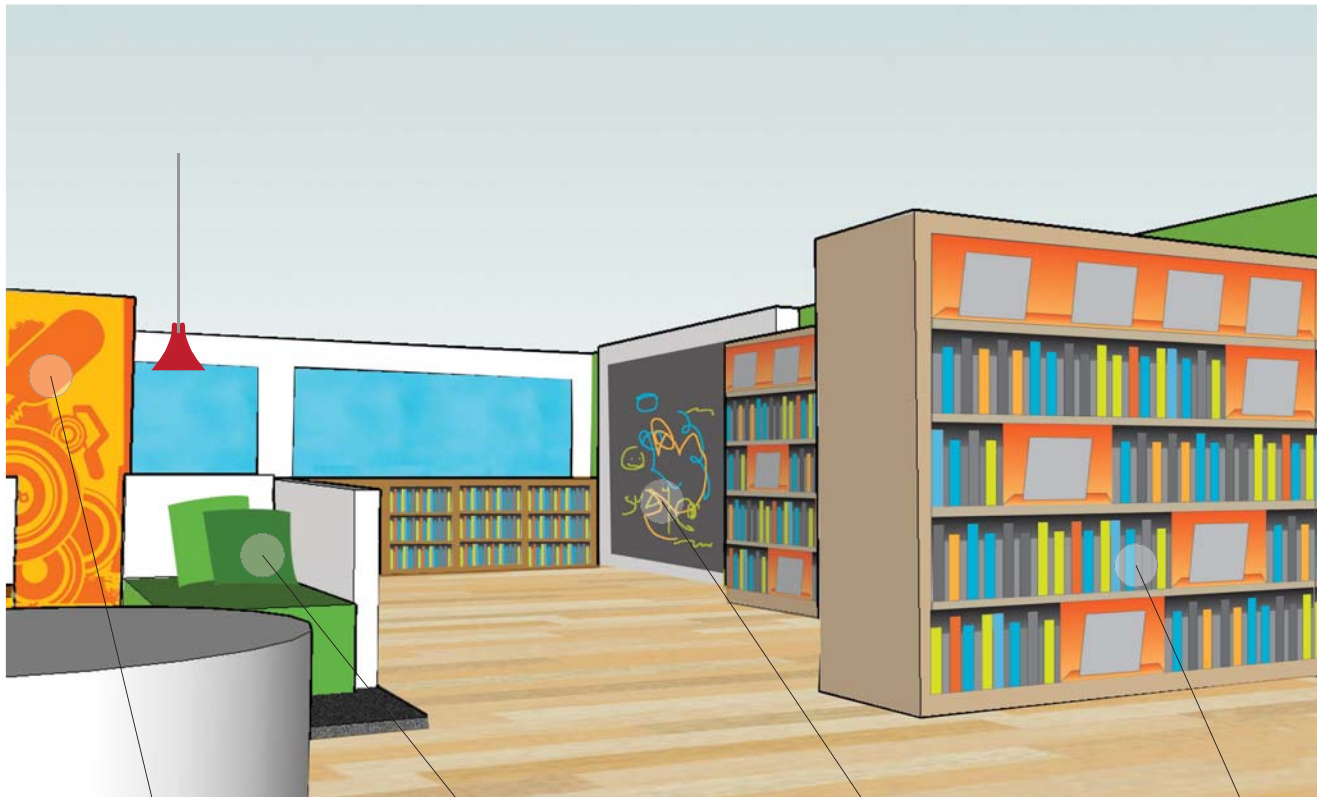
**COMPUTER STATIONS**  
Community spaces allow work and collaboration. Wi-fi is provided for those with laptops.

**WOOD FLOOR**  
All-wood floors create the bookstore-like feeling. The center lounge has carpet.

Cushion-like lounge allows for comfortable hanging-out and sharing of ideas.

## GRAPHIC WALL

A cool vinyl graphic applied to the wall creates interest and excitement.

Fun space to read and hang out. Walls offer a cozy yet open space to be.



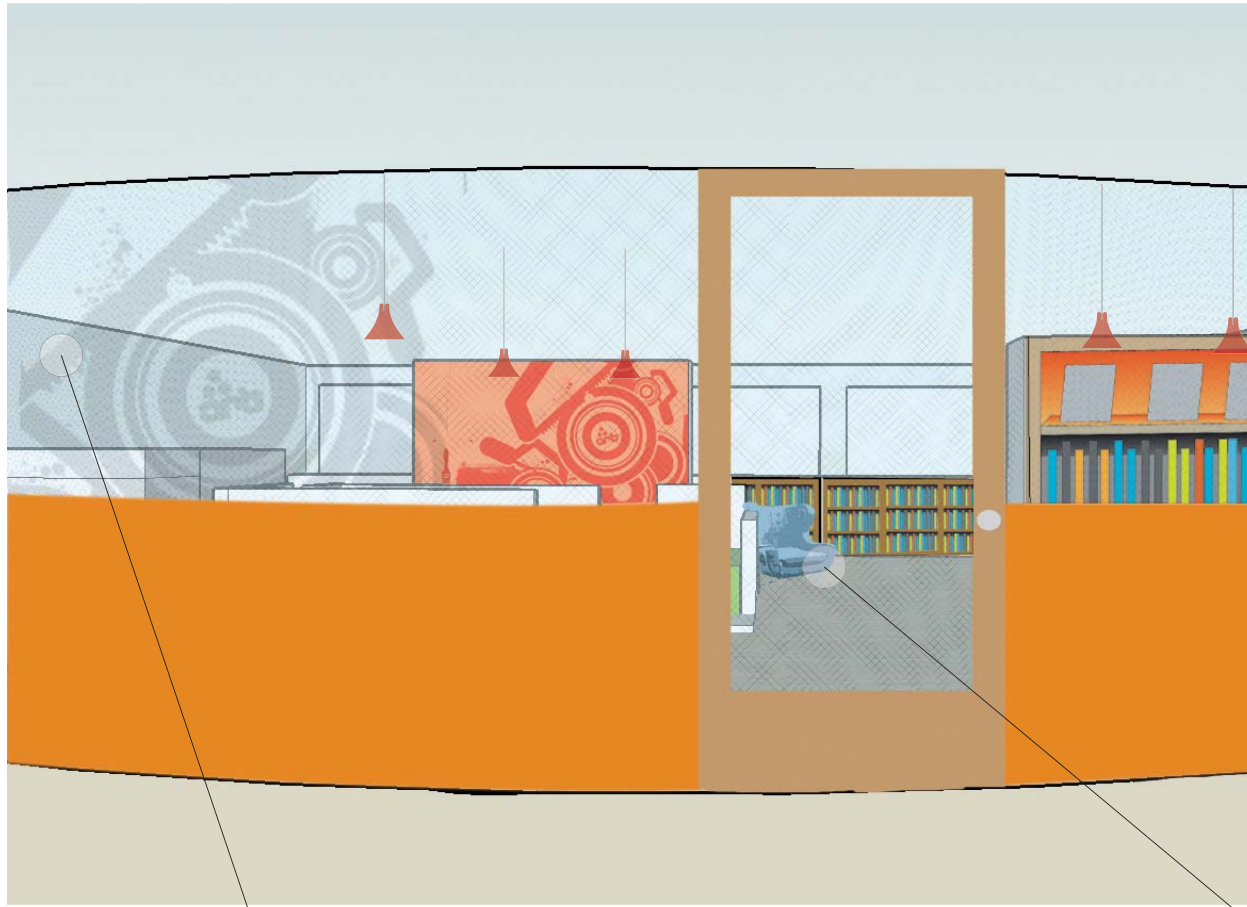
## GRAFFITI MURPHY STAGE

# TEEN AREA



## POLYCARBONATE WALLS WITH VINYL GRAPHICS

A wall creates separation. Polycarbonate material is lighter and safer than glass, and allows some transparency, yet some diffusion. A vinyl graphic applied to the poly will relate to the graphics inside.

## AUDIO SEATING

Moveable seating with audio capabilities gives teens a cool place to hang out and study, read or chill.
